Happy Pingu.

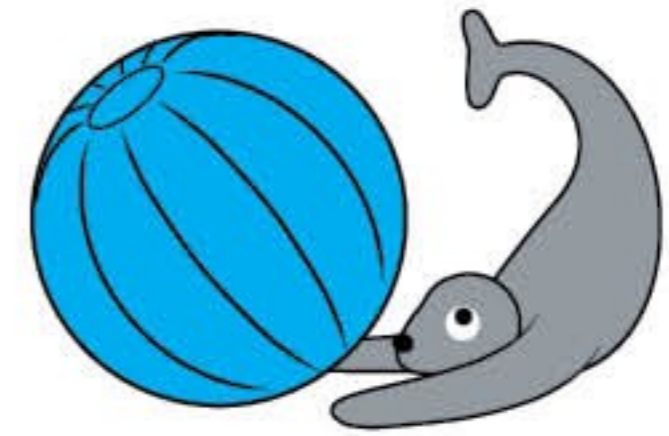
